

# Women With The World's Most Beautiful Face

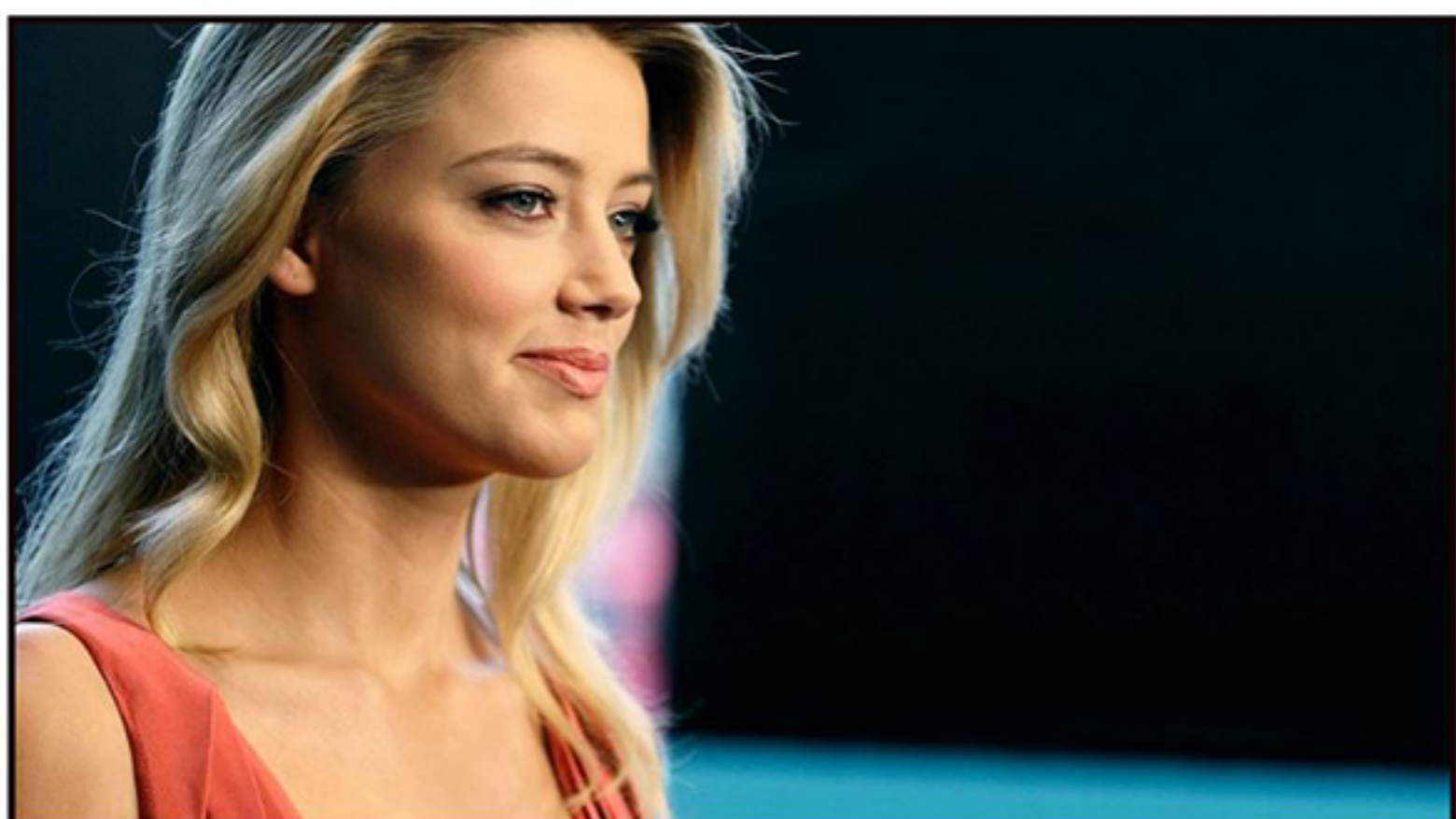

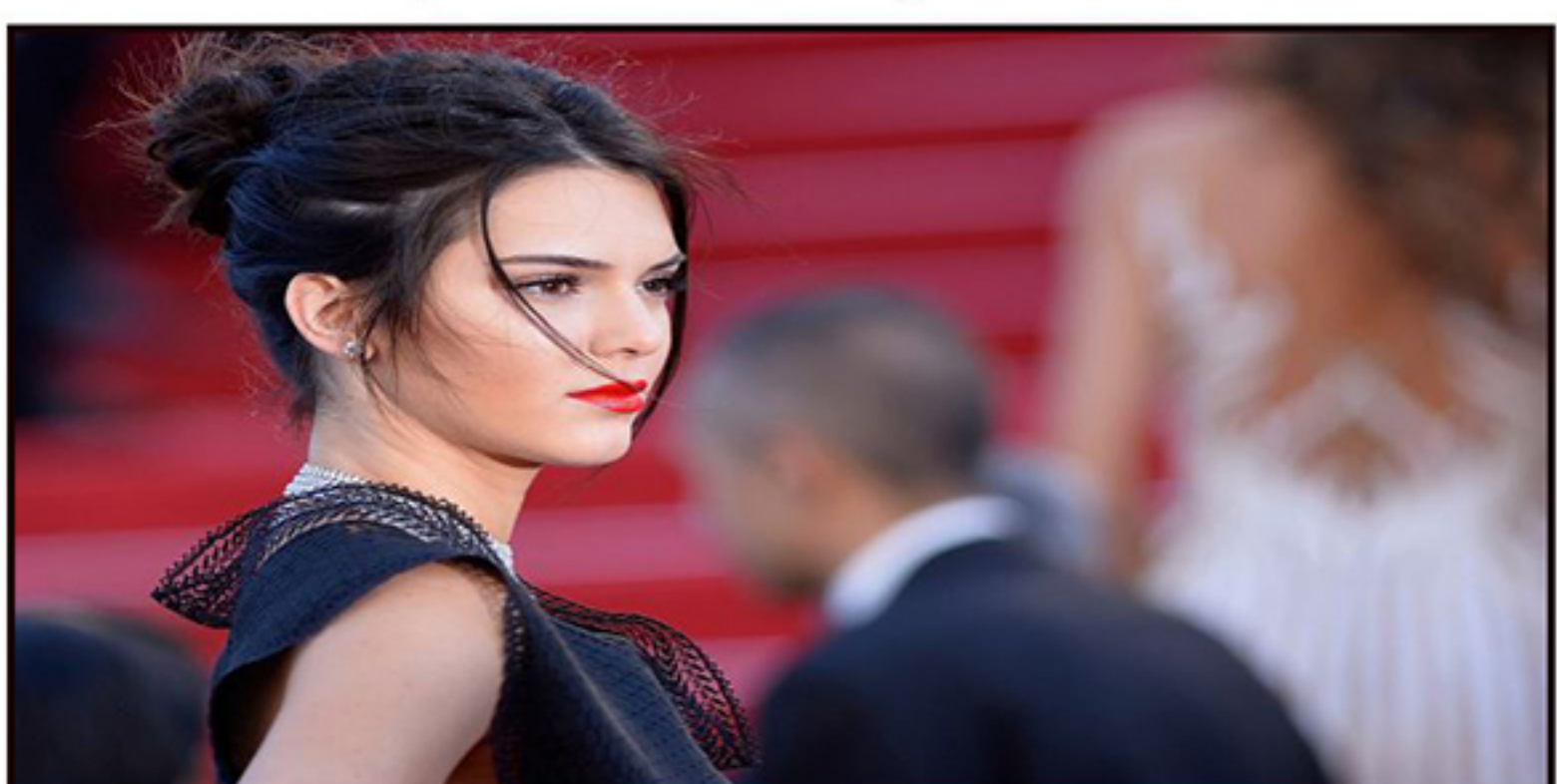
